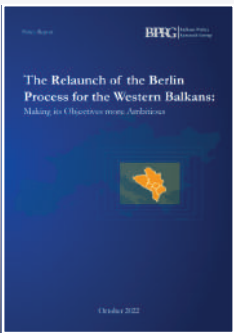

### Constitutional Framework, Parliamentarism, and Membership to the CoE



Balkans Group plays an important role in advocating for comprehensive reforms in Kosovo's constitutional framework, improvement of parliamentary procedures, and integration into the Council of Europe (CoE). A detailed review of the Constitution sparked informed debates on the system of laws, institutional functioning, and Constitutional Court jurisdiction. The legal analyses propose a constitutional review and legal designs to enhance legislative efficiency, improve institutional decision-making, ensure consistency in judicial case law, and implement constitutional guarantees for CoE membership. This platform for practical recommendations contributes to the evolving democratic landscape and has been instrumental for institutions and key stakeholders.
